

**The Cindy Burge Memorial ICP Grant** is offered each year by each USEA Area's Adult Rider Program to one of its Area's instructors who meet the grant's qualification standards and is selected as a recipient. These qualification standards include merit as an instructor, service to the sport, potential to provide future benefit to the sport, and demonstration of compatibility with the educational goals of ICP and intention to be assessed for ICP certification.

Area 4 will be awarding one \$250 grant this year to be used toward the Assessment Fee.
